- In addition, cooperations with several other organisations are in place to maximise synergies and to complement each other's work







NGM

- NGMN is established as a highly flexible and effective organisation with governance structures characterised by short decision-making paths, efficient processes as well as a pragmatic and project-oriented mode of operation
- The management bodies are the Board of Directors and the Strategy & Programme Committee (SPC)
- The Board decides on the strategic direction, project establishment, publication of results and the budget.
- The Work Programme consists of projects led by membership representatives and is supported by experts delegated by the membership. "Membership" includes Members, Contributors and Advisors.
- The role of the SPC is to prepare Board decisions with regards to new project proposals, to align projects from an overall perspective, and to supervise the current Work Programme
- The Forum serves as an open platform for information exchange amongst the membership, detailed discussion of all projects as well as regular update on innovations in technology, network architecture, applications and other

INTERNAL & EXTERNAL INTERACTIONS

PRAGMATIC APPROACH ADRESSING INDUSTRY & TECHNOLOGY OPPORTUNITIES & CHALLENGES

- NGMN identifies E2E architectural, functional and performance targets (radio & core network, service platforms, devices, etc.) as well as fundamental requirements for deployment scenarios and network operations
- NGMN publishes the results requirements, solutions, guidelines of its various initiatives as Publications, Blueprints and Liaison Statements
- NGMN provides impactful guidance to standardisation efforts, e.g. through ETSI, 3GPP and ITU, while also liaising with stakeholders in the evolving ecosystem, including open-source communities and related forums such as the Linux Foundation
- NGMN offers a platform for the industry to exchange information on critical and pressing issues, as well as to share experiences and lessons learnt
